Reminder of policy for cancellation of services due to COVID-19

The St. Andrew's Vestry, at its November meeting, adopted a policy that calls for in-person services to be canceled in the event that Delaware or Franklin county is designated at Level 4 (purple) on Ohio's public health advisory system.

In addition to the policy of canceling services if Delaware or Franklin county is designated purple, the Vestry also decided that should a COVID-19 outbreak be traced back to a contact at St. Andrew's, in-person services will be halted, and the church will follow appropriate safety procedures for re-opening.
