for facilitation of small group breakout sessions following each week's teaching. You'll receive a link to the Zoom program once you register, and small group discussion questions will be emailed each Thursday. Letting us know on the form if you'll be signing up individually or as a couple will also help us plan for the small groups.

This year's topic is "Recognizing God's Love and Leading in our Lives." The format will be similar to previous years, when we've met together in the Sanctuary. We will start with a short message each week, which will guide you through different aspects of spiritual formation/direction, followed by small group discussion in Zoom breakout sessions.
