Vestry elects officers, welcome new members

The St. Andrew's Vestry elected officers for the coming year and welcomed new members at its first meeting of 2022 on Monday, Jan. 17.

Officers are Eric Whitehead, senior warden; Chris Bryant, junior warden; Karen Osmond, clerk; and Larry Baldwin, treasurer. New members elected by the parish in November are Eric, Larry, Dan Brill and Carlo Cherubini. Eric is an incumbent, and Larry, Dan and Carlo served on Vestry previously. They will serve through 2024.

The Vestry also appointed Jim Oxenham, an incumbent who came in fifth by a narrow margin in November's election, to fill the unexpired term of Ryan Weiser, who resigned in December. Jim will serve through 2023.

Other members of Vestry are Steve Sattler and Pat Schmitz, who along with Chris and Karen will serve through 2022, and Eric Emery, Tony Gutierrez and Nikki Snead, who along with Jim will serve through 2023.

This information will also be in the 2021 Annual Report, which will be made available to the parish on Feb. 20, ahead of the Annual Parish Meeting, which is set for Sunday, Feb. 27, at 2:30 p.m.

St. Andrew's still needs more core team members to sponsor Afghan refugee family

St. Andrew's continues to explore sponsorship of a three-member refugee family from Afghanistan between March and August. Many church members have offered funding, donations and volunteering for occasional tasks, but we still need "core team" members.



Samaritan's Purse recommends that church sponsors have a strong core team. We specifically need team members to serve as leaders for Housing and Obtaining Benefits. We also need a team member to interact closely with the family and other volunteers as the Single Point of Contact (SPOC).

Core team members may spend an average of from five to 12 hours per week assisting the refugee family, with the time commitment higher at first and then decreasing as the family becomes more independent. Many tasks can be done on evenings and weekends.

Blessing Box Ministry share greatest needs

The Blessing Box at St. Andrew's is being used this winter, and your donations are always welcome!

Please bring your donated items to the Parish House or leave them in the bins at the church. Please, please do not put them in the blessing box! The box is checked daily to see what items need to be re-stocked and to check for expiration dates. A simple rule ... If it's out of date, old, or you wouldn't eat it yourself it's not worth donating!

Items we especially need include: Chicken, canned or in a pouch; tuna fish, canned or in a pouch; beef stew; canned chili; canned pulled pork; small canned hams; canned corned beef hash; canned pasta with meat or meat sauce; microwavable cups of mac 'n' cheese; microwavable cups of rice (not bags or boxes; these do not move); oatmeal packets; single servings of coffee; hot chocolate packets; pasta sauce in a can (no jars!); trail mixes / mixed nuts; cereal / granola bars; soups, ramen noodles, ramen bowls (please, no creamed soups); tissues; feminine supplies; soap, shower gels, shampoo / conditioner; body / hand lotion; lip balm sticks; gloves and socks; flavor packets for water bottles; boxed / shelf milk; fruits and vegetables (canned don't seem to move well; however, cups of fruit and apple sauce do!); and small cans of juice.

It's getting cold out there! Please remember to check our website before heading out for activities and events at the church if weather conditions are deteriorating, if roads are in poor driving condition, or if there are snow emergencies in Delaware or Franklin counties.

Please note that all events and activities at the church are canceled if there is a Level 3 snow emergency in Delaware County. If a cancellation affects a majority of the congregation, we'll send out a parish-wide e-mail and text message. Church service cancellations will be posted on local TV stations, as well.

Please check your phone number and email address on the Member Connection to make sure that we have your current contact information—before there's a weather emergency!

Log in at standrews.onechurchsoftware.com. From your dashboard select "View My Profile" under your name in the left-hand menu bar. Verify that your email address and phone number are correct. **If you have a mobile phone please make sure that you've selected "Mobile" from the drop-down menu to the left of the phone number.** That's the only way our system will know to generate a text message!

If you don't already have a login and password simply go to standrews.onechurchsoftware.com and click on the "Register" button. Enter your email address, then click on the blue "Check" button. If you get a message that "An account already exists with this email address," click on "Forgot Password?" to reset your password. If an account is not found for your email address enter your

If you wish to share your mailing address, birthday and other information with your fellow members remember to change the setting for those fields from "Church Leadership Only" to "My Group Members." **We recommend that you don't select "Everyone."**
